





Successful Proof of Concept: Value City Furniture

Value City Furniture in Ann Arbor, MI partnered with MML to provide instant and scheduled deliveries of customer purchased items.

Customers Download MML On-Demand app or used the QR Code

- Aug 2022 Sept 2022
- 23 customers made in-store purchases + MML Delivery
- 3 delivery agents covered Washtenaw, Jackson and Wayne county
- Increased exposure and sales for MML

Value City Furniture Data:

- Increased customer gratification with immediate delivery of furnishings
- Increased sales -- immediate delivery induced customers to buy
- Reduced warehouse man-hours for delivery processing
- Very helpful for students moving in, who don't have moving vehicles

Business Model

MML has four main Lines of Business: Mobility software system for dispatching, tracking, onboarding customers and freight agents, and delivery data analysis; Training, and Custom shipping load board for posting and booking deliveries. Revenues are derived from fee-based usage subscriptions, On-Demand e-Commerce and workforce development training.




